Registered Plant Awareness Training.

Here's two WHS regulatory requirements for 2025. Will you be compliant?

March 31st - Pressure vessels manufactured prior to 2022 must now be plant registered.

August 10th – operating non-slewing and slewing earthmoving machinery greater than 3 tonne as a crane will require licensing for high-risk work.

The new WA WHS Act 2020 and WHS (General and Mining) Regulations 2022 came into effect on 31 March 2022 and replaced the previously applicable Mines Safety & Inspection Act 1994 and the associated Mines Safety & Inspections Regulations 1995.

If you are a workplace supervisor, leading hand, planner, coordinator, engineer or a manager it is imperative to understand your registration and inspection compliance requirements. The aim of our industry-leading training course is to give you a fundamental understanding of registered plant and associated registration, inspection and record keeping obligations to remain compliant.
